

Getting to the conference venue

The conference will be held at the International Meeting Centre (Internationales Begegnungszentrum), or in short IBZ, located on the **TU Dortmund University campus North**.

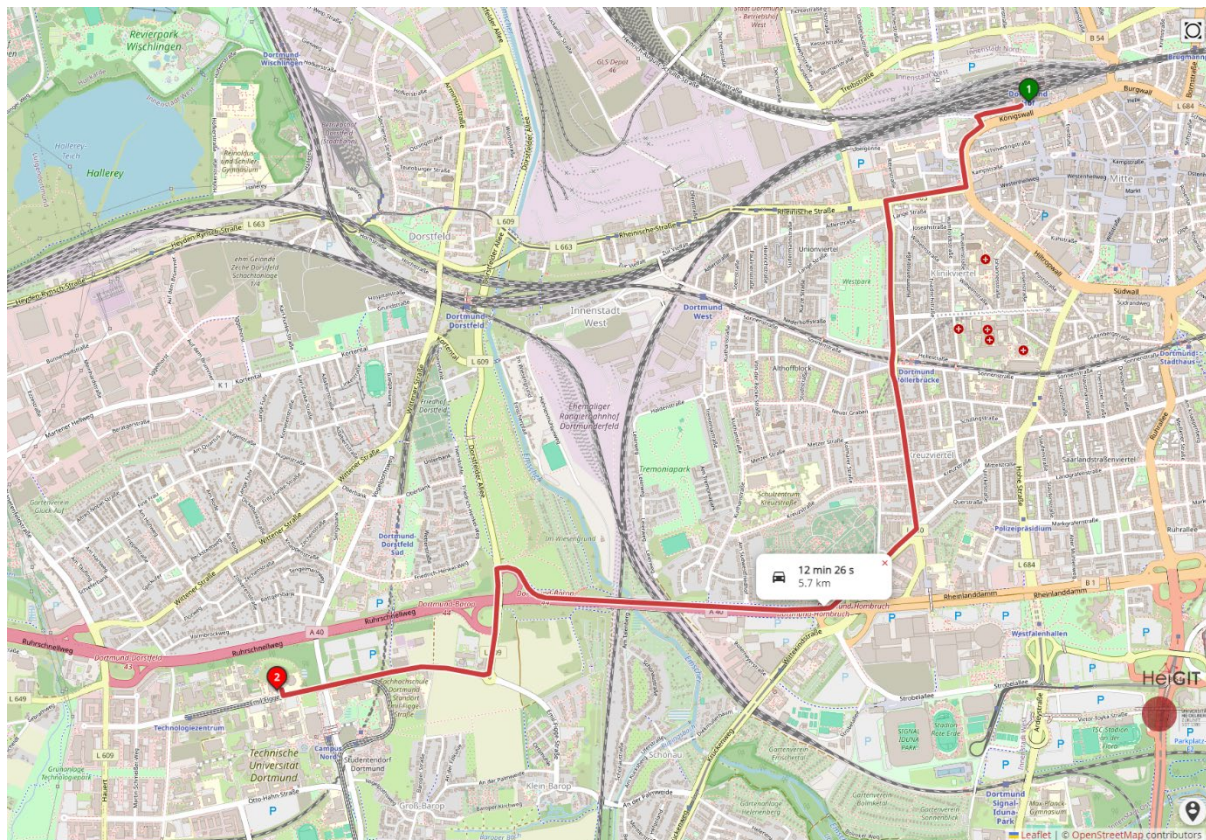

The campus of the TU is located on the south-western outskirts of Dortmund, Germany.



Arriving by taxi or car

The figure below shows a representative route departing from the central train station. The venue is located on the North campus of the TU Dortmund University. As such, it features plenty of free parking spaces. When choosing a taxi, the ride is expected to cost around 15 Euro. In order to take a taxi, leave the central train station towards the city centre and turn left. In the document *International visitor travel guide* an overview map is included, pointing out the taxi stop.

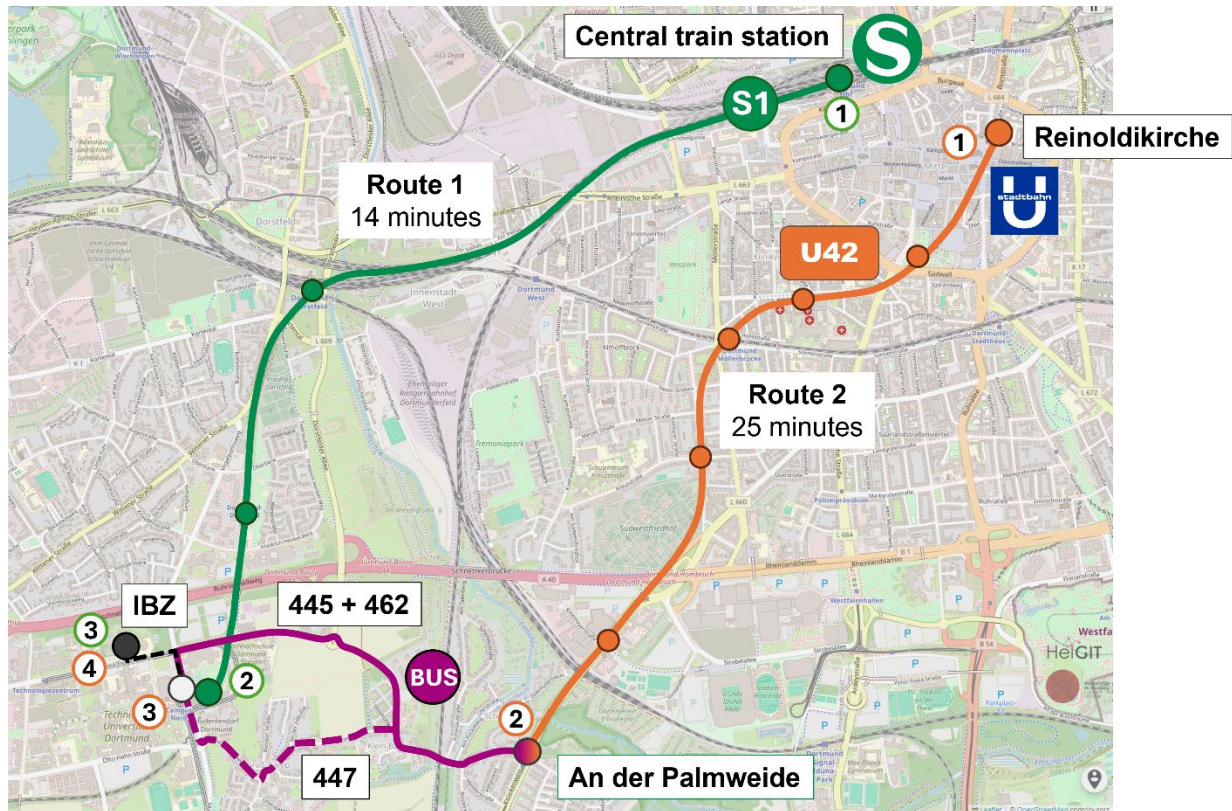


Route from central train station to conference venue by car

Arriving with public transportation

When taking public transportation, there are 2 options of arriving to the conference. The figure below shows the route of both options. Please check the live schedules to learn about delays and other potential disruptions.

Tickets can be bought at ticket machines, inside the bus as well as on transportation apps, such as the [VRR app](#) and the [DB app](#), which also have information on the live status of transportation. For further information please check the *International visitor guide*.



Route from city centre with public transportation

Route 1: from central station

1. Take the train to university

Board train **S1** (usually track 6 or 7)

Any direction is okay (usually it is either Düsseldorf, Essen or Solingen)

Get off at **Dortmund Universität** (3 stops)

Duration: 6 minutes

2. Walk to IBZ

Walk 500m (8 minutes)

Details see next map

Total duration: 14 minutes

Additional information

- The German word for central station is Hauptbahnhof and it is commonly abbreviated to just Hbf
- The S1 runs every 15 minutes

Route 2: from city centre

1. Take the metro

At the metro station **Reinoldikirche** board metro line **U42** towards **Hombruch**

Duration: 8 minutes

2. Switch to bus

Ride until **An der Palmweide** (6 stops)

Switch to bus (line 445, 447, 462) – see other maps for details

Duration: 6 minutes

3. Walk to IBZ

Get off at **Dortmund Universität (S)**

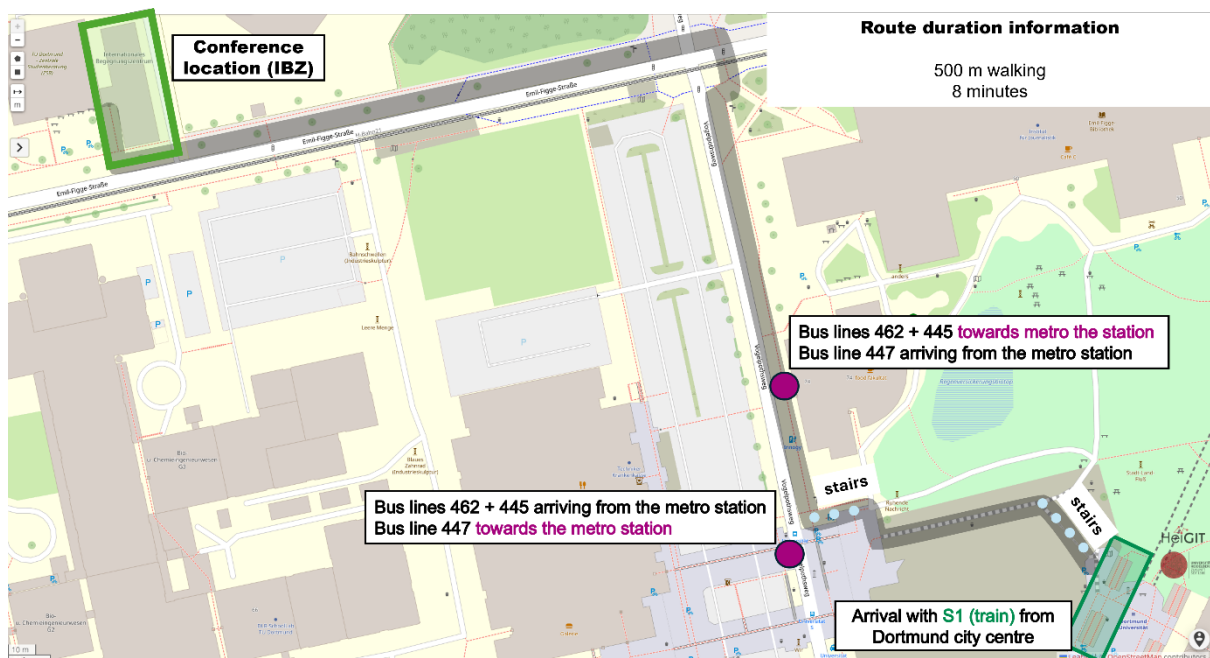
Walk 400m (6 minutes)

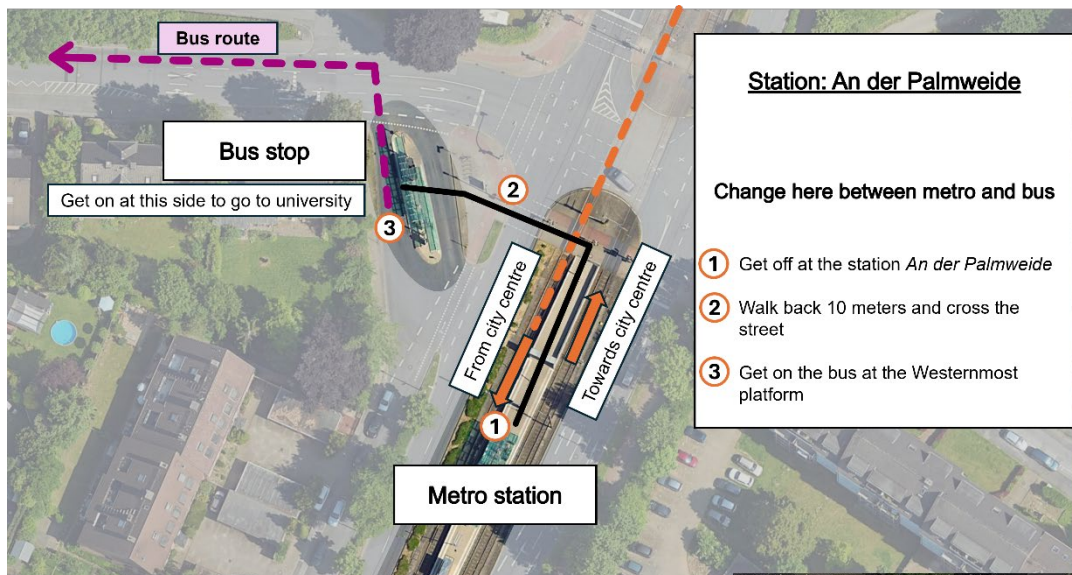
Total duration: 25 minutes

Additional information

- U42 runs every 10 minutes until about 20:20, then every 15 minutes
- Any bus on the Western most platform at *An der Palmweide* is okay to get to university
- At the bus stop *Dortmund Universität (S)*, bus line 447 stops on the opposite side of the street than bus line 445 and 462. Take care of this, when returning to the city centre
- If the bus stops at *An der Palmweide* it is written on the front of the bus



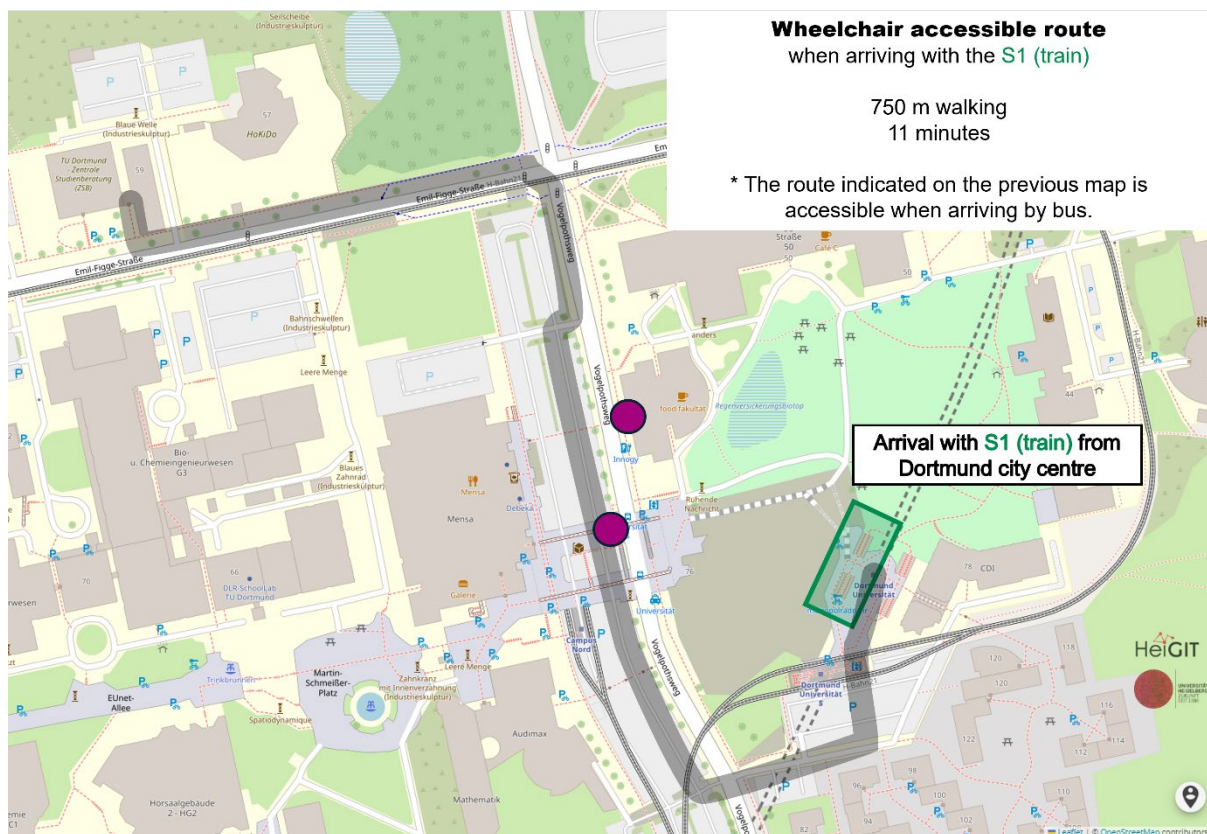
Walking route from the station to the conference venue marked in grey.

Wheelchair accessible route

Route 2 is accessible by wheelchair. For route 1 only the two set of stairs on the walking route from the train station to the IBZ are a challenge. They can be circumvented by a slight detour. Instead of going North, participants should head South after leaving the train station, walk until they reach a small street, turn right (heading West) until they get on the Vogelpothsweg and head North again until the traffic light, where they turn left again and can already see the conference venue. More details can be see in the figure below.

Getting to the conference dinner

The conference dinner is organised on Friday, 4th September at 19:00 in the brewery DAB, located in the North of Dortmund.

As it is in the North of Dortmund, the route takes you back to the city centre, so there are again 2 different routes available. Both routes have a similar duration. Information on the taxi option are given after the public transport routes.

Route 1: via central station

1. **Walk from IBZ to S-train station**
Walk 500 meters (8 minutes)
Details see other maps
2. **Take the train to city centre**
Board train **S1** (Destination Dortmund Hbf)
Get off at **Dortmund Hauptbahnhof** (3 stops)
Duration: 6 minutes
3. **Switch to metro line U41**
Follow the signage to the metro station
Board the **U41** with destination **Brechten Zentrum**
Get off at **Lortzingstraße** (3 stops, 4 minutes)
4. **Walk to the brewery**
Walk 600m (8 minutes)

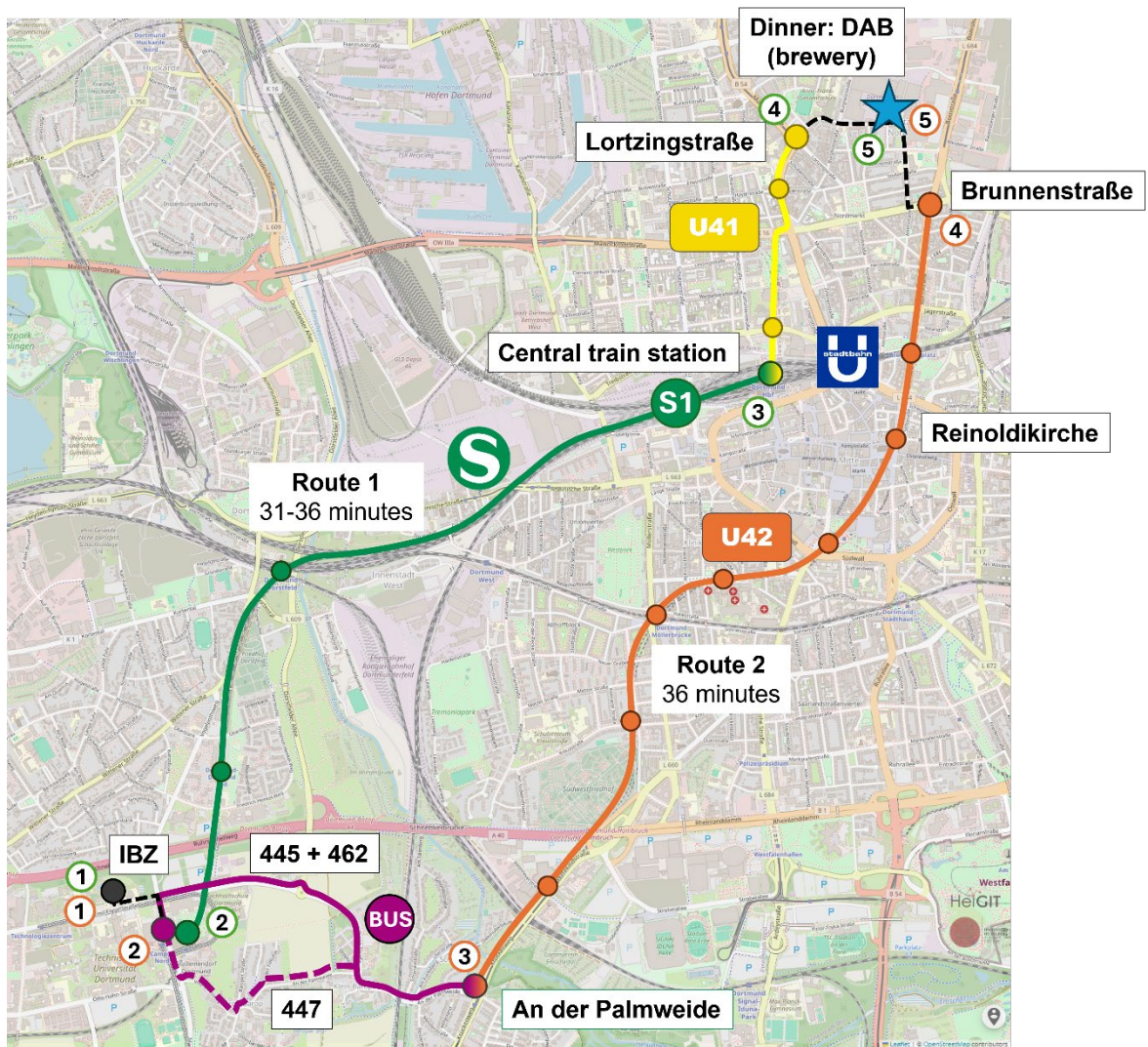
Total duration: 31 - 36 minutes

Route 2: via city centre

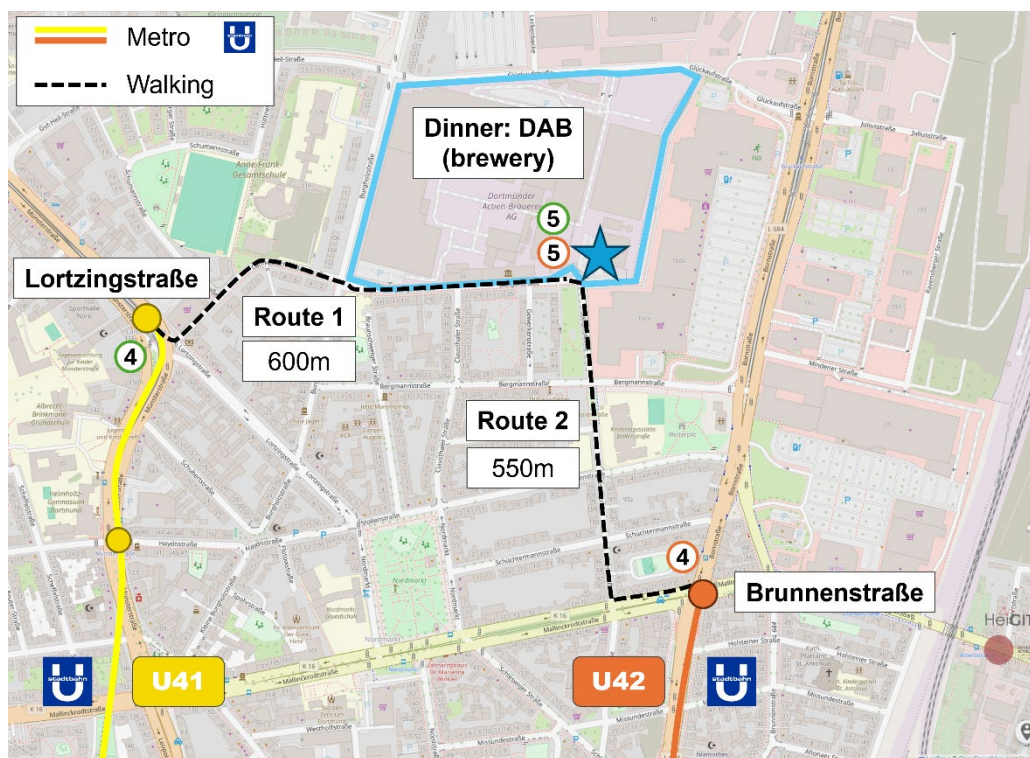

1. **Walk to bus stop**
Walk 400m (6 minutes)
2. **Take the bus to An der Palmweide**
Take the bus line 445, 447 or 462
Get off at **An der Palmweide** (6 minutes)
3. **Switch to metro line U42**
Take the metro **U42** towards **Grevel**
Get off at **Brunnestraße** (11 minutes)
4. **Walk to the brewery**
Walk 550m (8 minutes)

Total duration: 36 minutes

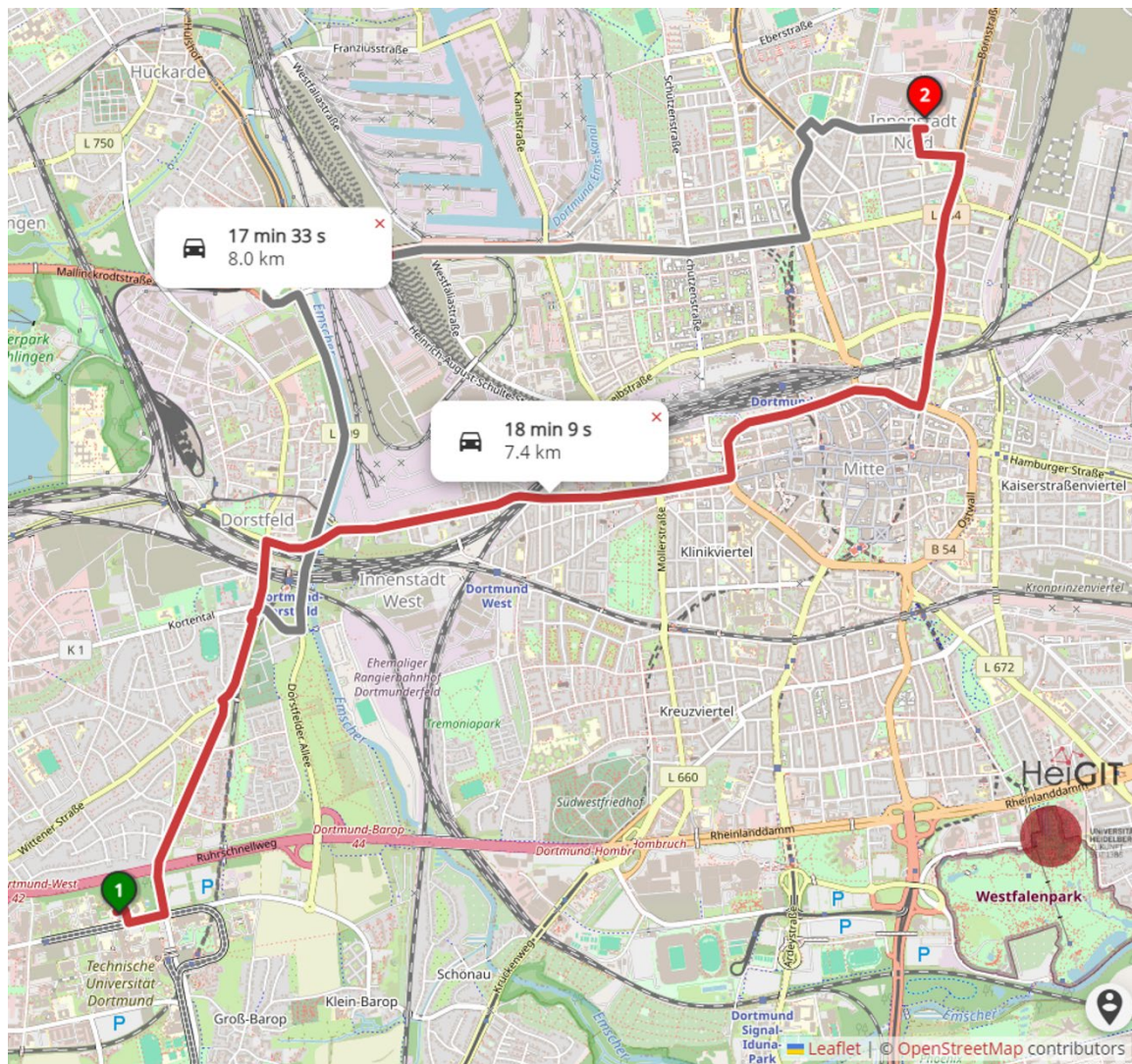


Route from the IBZ (conference location) to the DAB (conference dinner).

The participants are of course also free to arrive to the dinner by taxi. The ride will take about 18 minutes and with a distance of 7.4 km will approximately cost between 19 € and 22 €.
